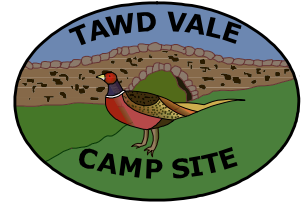

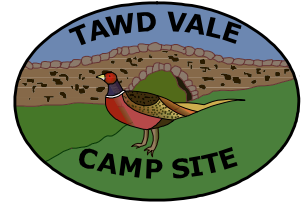

## Booking Conditions

**PRICES;** charges are reviewed on the 1<sup>st</sup> February each year. Any advanced booking will be adjusted to prices applicable at the date of use (not the date of booking) All cheques should be made payable to Tawd Vale Campsite.

**SITE OPENING;** The site is open from 6pm (1800hrs) on Friday evening until 4pm (1600hrs) on Sunday afternoon during term time. During school holidays opening at other times is possible by arrangement with the Site Manager [dave.price@merseysidescouts.com](mailto:dave.price@merseysidescouts.com)

**PROVISIONAL BOOKINGS;** A provisional booking may be re-allocated, if it has not been confirmed with a completed booking form and deposit, within 21 days of the provisional booking.

**DEPOSITS;** a deposit of £10 per camp site and £30 per building is required at the time of booking. The balance is due by the Saturday evening of a weekend hire and the day before the end of a week hire.

**CANCELLATION;** full fees will be payable for a cancellation within 8 weeks of the date of your visit.

**CHILD PROTECTION CODE OF PRACTICE;** Tawd Vale is a Scout Camp and as such all users must abide by the Scout Association's Child Protection Code of Practice. This code is contained in the 'Young People First' card (the yellow card). In particular it must be understood that any contravention of the Code of Practice could lead to The Scout Association initiating its own reporting and referral procedures. If your organisation has a Child Protection Policy please supply us with a copy. Prior to any booking being confirmed you must sign and date the declaration either as a scout member or as a leader with another organisation.

**INSURANCE;** Scout association Insurance ONLY covers members of the Scout Association. If you are a non-scout association organisation YOU ARE NOT COVERED BY US and must arrange your own insurance for everything involved during your stay at the site.

If you are a non-scout organisation you must sign the enclosed declaration before we accept your booking.

**GROUP BEHAVIOUR;** This is the responsibility of the group leadership team. Campers not showing respect for other campers may be asked to leave the site and it will be the responsibility of the leaders to arrange for campers to leave. It is expected that there will be quiet between 2300hrs and 0730hrs.

**VEHICLES; VEHICLES AND CONTENTS ARE LEFT ENTIRELY AT THE OWNERS RISK. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED CAR PARKS UNLESS OTHERWISE INSTRUCTED BY CAMP STAFF.**

### ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

**ARRIVAL;** The site is open from 1800hrs on a Friday. Please do not arrive before this time as our Volunteer Staff will not be on site.

On arrival please report to Reception. No campers should go on site without the knowledge of the duty staff. If your group is being brought to the site by parents then the young people must be met by leaders at Reception. Visitor's cars must be parked in the Main Car Park.

**DEPARTURE;** It is expected that all campers will have left the site by 1600hrs on a Sunday to allow our Volunteer Staff to clean and close the site. Young people should be escorted back to the Main Car Park at the end of the weekend. Adults should not come to camp sites to meet young people. This is a Child Protection issue.

Arrival and departure for week camps is by arrangement with the Site Manager.

**GENERAL NOTES**

**ACCIDENTS AND EMERGENCIES:** All accidents must be reported to Duty Staff and the appropriate forms filled in as required by the Scout Association. If the matter requires emergency vehicles then staff must be informed so they can make sure these vehicles will have clear access to the site.

**EMERGENCY SITUATION:** SHOULD THERE BE A NEED FOR EVACUATION OF CAMP SITES THEN A PROLONGED RINGING OF THE BELL BY RECEPTION WILL TAKE PLACE. ON HEARING THIS ALL CAMPERS SHOULD REPORT TO THE MAIN CAR PARK AND LEADERS IN CHARGE SHOULD COMPLETE A ROLL CALL AND INFORM DUTY STAFF WHEN ALL SITES ARE CLEARED.

**SITE SERVICE:** It is expected that campers look after the area around their site and the toilet block nearest to their site. Cleaning materials and refuse bags are available from Duty Staff. Please make sure this happens as it makes life easier all round and it is not expected that it will take a great deal of time.

**BOOKING APPLICATION FORM NOTES**
